Clue: It's next to a very Grand building, but you'll have to go round the back!

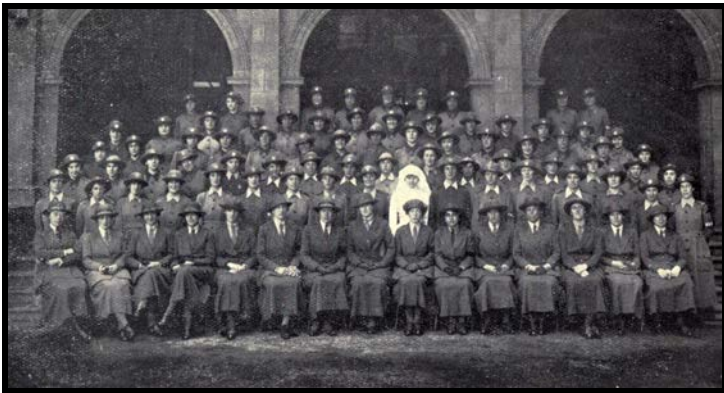

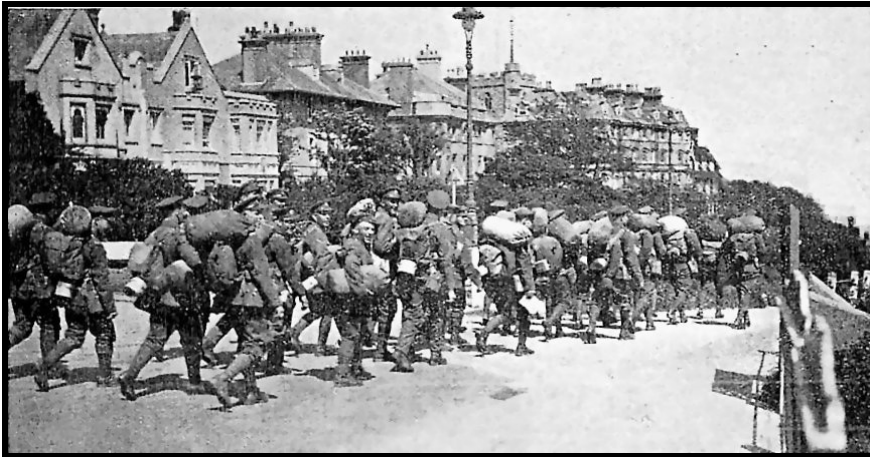
